County jail after Judge Edward J. Ascher upheld his conviction and fine in Municipal Court. Each day in jail will cut \$5 from the fine.

Nine men and women from

the parents Aid Society of Hempstead, L. I., and a newly formed group called Citizens for Baird, picketed the Hall of Records here for 1½ hours in protest.
